JAN 12 - SUNDAY HOUSTON / TEL AVIV

Depart Houston to Istanbul.

JAN 13 - MONDAY ISTANBUL / TIBERIAS

Arrive Istanbul. Change planes to Tel Aviv. Arrive in Tel Aviv airport late afternoon. Transfer directly to Tiberias for dinner and overnight.

JAN 14 - TUESDAY CANA / NAZARETH / BASILICA OF THE ANNUNCIATION / MAGDALA


We start the day with a visit to Cana, the village of Jesus' first miracle of changing water into wine; here couples may renew their wedding vows. Continue to the Basilica of the Annunciation in Nazareth and have Mass. Visit the Church of St. Joseph. This afternoon visit the Magdala Synagogue and the very unique prayer space and art work on campus. Dinner and overnight in Tiberias.

JAN 15 - WEDNESDAY THE MINISTRY OF CHRIST IN THE GALILEE: TIBERIAS / BOAT RIDE ON SEA OF GALILEE / CAPERNAUM / MT. BEATITUDES / MT. TABOR

Take a boat ride across the Sea of Galilee, then visit Capernaum to see the synagogue and St. Peter's house, the Mount of the Beatitudes where the Sermon on the Mount was given and where you will have Mass, Tabgha to see the splendid mosaic about the miracle of the loaves and fishes, and the nearby Church of Peter's Primacy where Peter was told "Feed my lambs, feed my sheep." This afternoon visit Mount Tabor, scene of the Transfiguration. Dinner and overnight at your hotel in Tiberias.

IAN 16 - THURSDAY PETRA


Leave the Galilee and transfer to Sheikh Hussein Bridge to cross into Jordan. Visit Mt. Nebo, to view, as Moses did, the Holy Land; visit the church, have Mass, then drive to Madaba. See the 4th century mosaic floor map, then continue to Petra for dinner and overnight.

IAN 17 - FRIDAY PETRA / AMMAN

Today you will tour Petra, correctly called the "eighth wonder of the world." This entire city of rose-colored temples and amphitheaters is carved from the multi-hued rock cliffs which surround its hidden valley. From this city came the family of Herod the Great, who slaughtered the infants of Bethlehem. You enter the city through a narrow passage, surrounded by colorful and beautiful 300 ft cliffs, and at the end of the Siq, you will see the impressive Treasury, hewn out of the solid rock from the side of the mountain. It is about 140 feet high and 90 feet wide. See the Amphitheatre, city center, and the Monastery. Travel to Amman for dinner and overnight

JAN 18 - SATURDAY ALLENBY BRIDGE / BAPTISMAL SITE / JERICHO / JERUSALEM

This morning return to Israel from Jordan across the Allenby bridge. Visit Betharbara, where John the Baptist baptized Jesus. Continue to Jericho. Visit the excavations of the oldest city in the world and view the Mount of Temptation where Jesus fasted and was tempted by Satan. Time for Mass. This afternoon we will relax beside the mineral-rich waters of the Dead Sea, renowned for its healing properties with time for a swim or (or rather a float!). After the Dead Sea we will proceed up through the Judean hills to the Holy City of Jerusalem. Dinner and overnight in Jerusalem.

JAN 19 - SUNDAY OUR LADY OF PALESTINE / EIN KAREM


This morning we visit the Shrine of Our Lady of Palestine, patroness of the Equestrian Order of the Holy Sepulchre, and have Mass. After lunch head to the village of Ein Karem, the birthplace of St. John the Baptist, and the Church of Visitation where the Blessed Virgin Mary visited her cousin, Elizabeth, and proclaimed the Magnificat. Dinner and overnight at the hotel in Jerusalem.

JAN 20 - MONDAY BETHLEHEM

Visit the Shepherds' Fields, where the caves have soot marks of the fires that shepherds lit to keep warm while watching over their flocks. Visit Bethlehem University for a chance to see the campus of this Catholic center of hope, which is supported by the Order. Lunch will be prepared by the students of the catering school and students will join each table. You will gain a unique insight into daily life in present day Bethlehem from young students. Then to Manger Square which stands in front of one of the oldest of Christian churches, the Church of the Nativity. Enter the Church and down to the Grotto of the Nativity which marks the spot of Jesus' birth. Beneath the Altar, there is a silver star with the Latin inscription: HIC DE VIRGINE MARIA JESUS CHRISTUS NATUS (Here Jesus Christ was born to the Virgin Mary.) Have Mass at the Church of the Nativity.

JAN 21 - TUESDAY THE PASSION OF JESUS: MOUNT OF OLIVES / DOMINUS FLEVIT / GETHSEMANE / CAVE OF BETRAYAL / PATER NOSTER / UPPER ROOM / ST. PETER IN GALLICANTU

Visit the Mount of Olives to walk the Palm Sunday route stopping at Dominus Flevit, where Jesus wept over Jerusalem. Drive to Gethsemane and view the Rock of Agony where Jesus prayed His last prayer before his arrest. Visit the Cave of

Betrayal and Pater Noster, with the Lord's Prayer in many languages. Drive through the Kidron Valley to St. Peter in Gallicantu where Peter denied Him thrice. At the Cenacle, visit the Upper Room of the Last Supper. Finish the day at Dormition Abbey where tradition says the Blessed Virgin Mary died. Dinner and overnight at the hotel in Jerusalem.

JAN 22 - WEDNESDAY STATIONS OF THE CROSS / CHURCH OF THE HOLY SEPULCHRE / LATIN PATRIARCHATE

We begin to retrace the last steps of Jesus. As we walk along the Via Dolorosa (Way of Sorrow) through the markets of the Old City, praying the Stations of the Cross, we reflect on the greatness of His sacrifice. Pray at Calvary and celebrate Solemn High Mass at the Holy Tomb. After breakfast at our hotel, we visit the Latin Patriarchate and participate in the Pilgrim Shell Ceremony. Visit St. Anne's Church, the home of the Virgin Mary and her parents Saints Joachim and Anne. We pass the Ecce Homo where Pilate proclaimed, "Behold the man." Dinner and overnight at the hotel in Jerusalem.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

The Tour Price Includes:

Air Transportation: Airfare is based on special contract agreements with various international airlines and include certain restrictions and deadlines. These fares are subject to cancellation penalties, and once tickets are issued, they are NON-REFUNDABLE, NON-TRANSFERABLE AND CANNOT BE USED TOWARDS FUTURE TRAVEL. Please refer to our CANCELLATION AND REFUND POLICY below. Airfare and tour prices are based on prices effective as of JANUARY 1, 2025 and are subject to change without notice.

Surface/Land Transportation: All surface/land transportation described in the itinerary will be provided by modern motor coach, designed for highway travel. Groups will be met and transferred upon arrival and departure.

Hotels: We only use first-class hotels. Hotel accommodations are based on double occupancy (2 per room). We reserve the right to substitute hotels of similar quality for those specified in the itinerary.

Single Room Supplements: If you would like a single room, there is an additional cost of **\$1,200.00** that will be added to the tour price. Single rooms are limited and will be reserved on a first come first serve basis. If you request a roommate and none is available, you will be considered a "forced single," and charged one half (½) of the Single Room Supplement cost.

Meal Plan: Meal plans include three (3) meals per day, breakfast, lunch, and dinner, with timing depending on the itinerary. Taxes and service charges normally appearing on restaurant bills are included in the tour price for these meals. A list of any and all dietary requests or food allergies must be emailed to cathy@inspirationaltoursinc.com for hotel/airline accommodation at least seven (7) days before departure. We cannot guarantee any dietary accommodations but will make all efforts to secure special dietary requests. In the event airlines or hotels are unable to accommodate dietary requests, you will be responsible for your meals; it is the individual's responsibility to choose appropriate foods while on the tour. Unused meals will NOT be reimbursed.

Baggage: Inspirational Tours, Inc. restricts all passengers to one (1) piece of checked luggage (max. 50 lbs.) and one (1) carry-on (max. 18 lbs.). All passengers should check with the airline for up-to-date baggage weight/dimension information and restrictions, which are subject to change at any time before departure.

Airport Taxes and Fuel Surcharges: are included in the tour price and are subject to change.

Tips On The Tour: Tips to guides, porters, headwaiters, and drivers are included in the tour price, unless otherwise specified.

The Tour Price Does Not Include: Expenses related to issuance/renewal of passports, laundry, mineral waters, wine & liquor, after-lunch/dinner tea, coffee, or food not included in the meal plan above; additional baggage; expenses of carriages, guides, sightseeing or other services other than those specifically mentioned as included in the itinerary; insurance for baggage or personal trip or health insurance; all items of a personal nature, in addition to those not listed above as being included in the tour price.

Booking Conditions: Deposits and Payment: A non-refundable deposit of \$300.00 per person, payable via cash, check or money order, is required at the time of registration. No registration will be processed without a deposit. Invoices for final balances are issued at or near 90 days before departure. Full and final payment is due 60 days before departure. Registrations received within 90 days of departure require payment in full. If there is any outstanding balance by the Final Payment due date listed on your invoice, all travel services will be subject to automatic cancellation and cancellation fees will apply. A service reinstatement fee may be added to your invoice and must be paid in advance in order to apply for reconfirmation of services. WE ONLY ACCEPT CASH, CHECKS OR MONEY ORDERS FOR THE REGISTRATION FEE. Payment by credit card is accepted ONLY for final balances or payments towards final balances; all credit card payments will be assessed a 3% non-refundable convenience fee, which will be added to the total amount being charged.

Cancellations and Refund Policy: All cancellations MUST BE RECEIVED IN WRITING VIA FAX, E-MAIL OR U.S. MAIL. The date of the cancellation request is the date used for purposes of any assessed cancellation fees. Please note that the Registration Fees are NON-REFUNDABLE as stated on the Registration Form. Cancellation fees (as to any monies paid over the deposit for a tour with a non-refundable deposit) depend on the timing of the cancellation request, and are as follows: request received between time of registration and up to 90 days prior to departure—automatic \$100.00 cancellation fee; request received within 89 to 60 days prior to departure—automatic \$300.00 cancellation fee; request received within 59 to 30 days prior to departure—cancellation fee of 50% of tour cost; request received 29 days or less prior to departure through date of departure—assessed 100% of the tour cost (air and land, and any deviation fees) as the cancellation fee. Additional charges/fees for deviations and/or upgraded seats may require full payment at time of booking/confirmation and may be non-refundable: if a non-refundable air ticket has been issued prior to receiving notice of a cancellation request, you will be 100% responsible for those fees, in addition to the cancellation penalties listed above. Package cancellation fees include airfare. Once airfare is purchased, either at time of booking, including but not limited to, deviations or seat upgrade requests, or at time of full payment, airline tickets will be issued and are always subject to a 100% penalty. Validity date on passports must be for at least six (6) months after the date of return of the tour as per the tour dates, or any deviation request. If we do not receive a copy of your current passport, the information you provide on your Registration Form will be used for ticketing purposes. If ANY information provided (name, date of birth, etc.) does not match what is on your passport, you may be subject to penalties or fees for corrections to airline tickets, and/or may be denied boarding by the airline. Any name change, including minor spelling corrections, may require reservations to be canceled and re-booked. Reservations will then be subject to availability and pricing at the time of re-booking; any increase in airfare will be borne by the passenger.
