### The Tour Price Includes:

**Air Transportation:** Airfares are based on special contract agreements with various international airlines and involve certain restrictions and deadlines. These fares are subject to cancellation penalties, and once they are issued, are **NON-REFUNDABLE, NON-TRANSFERABLE AND CAN'T BE USED TOWARDS FUTURE TRAVEL.** Please refer to our **CANCELLATION AND REFUND OF AIR AND LAND ARRANGEMENTS CLAUSE/POLICY** below. Airfares are based on prices in effect as of **JANUARY 1, 2019**, and they are subject to change without notice.

### IT IS HIGHLY RECOMMENDED THAT YOU PURCHASE TRAVEL INSURANCE.

**Surface Transportation:** All surface transportation as described in the itinerary will be by modern motorcoach designed for highway travel. Groups will be met and transferred on arrival and departure.

**Hotels:** First class Hotels. Hotel classifications as per ratings on OHRG published by Ziff-Davis Company in New York. Hotels are double occupancy (2 people per room).

**Single room** additional cost **\$1200.00**. Single rooms are limited and will be awarded on a first come first serve basis. If you request a roommate and none are available, you will pay ½ this amount as a forced single room.

**Meal Plan:** The meal plan is FULL board, 3 meals per day, consists of breakfast, lunch, and dinner, depending on the routine of the itinerary. Taxes and service charges normally appearing on the restaurant bills are included in the tour price. **A list of all food allergies must be emailed to [insptours@aol.com](mailto:insptours@aol.com) for hotel accommodation. In the case the hotel is unable to accommodate, passenger is responsible for all meals. Unused meals will NOT be reimbursed.**

**Baggage:** INSPIRATIONAL TOURS restricts all tour passengers to 1 piece of checked luggage and 1 carry-on. **All Passengers should check with the airline for up-to-date baggage weight and dimension information and restrictions which are subject to change at anytime before tour departure.**

**Cancellation and Refund Policy:** All cancellations **MUST BE RECEIVED IN WRITING VIA FAX, E-MAIL OR REGULAR U.S. MAIL.** Automatic \$100.00 cancellation fee up to 90 days prior to departure; 89 to 60 days prior to departure \$200.00 cancellation fee; 59 to 30 days prior to departure **50%** of tour cost cancellation fee; 29 days prior to departure up to date of departure **100%** of tour cost cancellation fee; **Total loss of tour costs, Air and Land. If non-refundable air tickets have been issued prior to receiving notice of your cancellation, you will be charged the price of the ticket in addition to the cancellation penalties listed above.**

## TOUR ITINERARY:

### Sep 22 Sunday – Houston / Frankfurt

Depart Houston to Frankfurt.

### Sep 23 Mon – Frankfurt / Tel Aviv

Arrive in Frankfurt and change planes to Tel Aviv. Upon arrival, you will be met and transferred to your hotel in Tel Aviv. **Mass at St Peter Church or hotel (depending on time of arrival)**

### Sep 24 Tue – Stella Maris / Nazareth / Basilica of the Annunciation / Cana

Travel to Stella Maris, a Carmelite Monastery with the Madonna of Mt. Carmel. Continue to the Basilica of Annunciation in Nazareth for Mass and the Church of the Holy Family. We end the day with a visit to Cana, the village of Jesus' first miracle of changing water into wine; here couples may renew their wedding vows. Dinner and overnight at your hotel in Tiberias. **Mass at the Basilica of the Annunciation**

### Sep 25 Wed – The Ministry of Christ In the Galilee: Tiberias/Boat Ride / Sea of Galilee / Capernaum / Mt. of Beatitudes

Some of today's highlights are a boat ride across the Sea of Galilee to Capernaum to see the synagogue and St. Peter's house, a visit to the Mount of Beatitudes where the Sermon on the Mount was given and have Mass. You will also visit Tabgha to see the splendid mosaic about the miracle of the loaves and fishes, and the nearby Church of Peter's Primacy where Peter was told "Feed my lambs, feed my sheep." Stop at Magdala, the town of St. Mary Magdalene. Dinner and overnight in Tiberias. **Mass at the Mount of the Beatitudes**

### Sep 26 Thu – Mt. Tabor / Ein Karem / Jerusalem

Begin the day with Mass at Mount Tabor, the site of the

Transfiguration. Afterward drive through the Jezreel Valley and then up the Judean hills towards the Holy City of Jerusalem. Visit the village of Ein Karem, the birthplace of St. John the Baptist, then head back to your hotel for dinner and overnight. **Mass at Mount Tabor**

### Sep 27 Fri – Bethlehem: Church of the Nativity / Bethlehem University / Shepherd's Fields

Travel to Bethlehem to visit Bethlehem University, the only Catholic University in the Holy Land, one of the institutions supported by the Order. After lunch we will go to the Church of the Nativity that stands upon the site where Jesus was born and celebrate Mass. We will visit the Shepherd's Fields where the angels announced the birth of Jesus. We will have some time to shop before heading to our hotel for dinner and overnight in Jerusalem. **Mass at the Church of the Nativity**

### Sep 28 Sat – The Passion of Jesus: Mount of Olives / Gethsemane / Upper Room / St. Peter in Gallicantu

We begin our day on the Mount of Olives to walk the Palm Sunday route stopping at Dominus Flevit, where Jesus wept over Jerusalem. Drive to Gethsemane and have Mass in the Church of All Nations on the Rock of Agony where Jesus prayed His last prayer before His arrest. Visit the Pater Noster, with the Lord's Prayer in many languages, and drive through the Kidron Valley to St. Peter in Gallicantu, where Peter denied Him thrice. At the Cenacle, we visit the Upper Room of the Last Supper then finish the day at Dormition Abbey, where we believe the Blessed Mary died. Dinner and overnight at the hotel in Jerusalem. **Mass at the Church of All Nations in Gethsemane**

### Sep 29 Sun – The Wilderness: Bethany / Jericho / Mt. Temptation / Dead Sea

Stop for morning Mass at St. Lazarus Church in Bethany.

Then head to Jericho; the desert east of Jerusalem is rich in Christian tradition. At the oasis town of Jericho, visit the excavations of the oldest city in the world and view Mt. Temptation where Jesus fasted and was tempted by Satan. On the way back there is time for a swim (or rather a float!) in the mineral-rich waters of the Dead Sea, renowned for its healing properties. Dinner and overnight at the hotel in Jerusalem. **Mass at St. Lazarus Church in Bethany**

### Sep 30 Mon – Stations of the Cross / Church of the Holy Sepulchre / Latin Patriarchate

We begin to retrace the steps of Jesus as we walk along the Via Dolorosa (Way of Sorrow) through the markets of the Old City. While praying the Stations of the Cross, we reflect on the greatness of His sacrifice. Celebrate Solemn High Mass at the Holy Tomb. After breakfast at our hotel, we visit the Latin Patriarchate and participate in the Pilgrim Shell Ceremony. Dinner and overnight at the hotel in Jerusalem. **Solemn High Mass at the Holy Tomb**

### Oct 01 Tue – Jerusalem / Tel Aviv Airport / Rome

Transfer to the airport and fly to Rome. Upon arrival, you will be met by your tour guide and have a tour of Rome to include the Basilicas of St. Mary Major and St. John Lateran (Cathedral of Rome), and the Holy Cross in Jerusalem. This last basilica was consecrated around 325 to house the Passion Relics brought to Rome from the Holy Land by St. Helena of Constantinople, mother of the Roman Emperor Constantine. At that time, the basilica floor was covered with soil from Jerusalem, thus acquiring the title "in Jerusalem". Return to your hotel for dinner and overnight in Rome. **Mass at St. Mary Major**

### Oct 02 Wed – Rome / Papal Audience

This morning, attend the Papal Audience if the Holy Father is in Rome. After lunch, visit St. Peter's Basilica, the largest church in the world, and the Vatican museum, with its halls of paintings, tapestries, and statuary, and the breathtaking Sistine Chapel. Then you will have a tour of St. Paul's Outside the Walls Basilica, and the ancient catacombs, where early Christians were buried. Then dinner and overnight at your hotel in Rome. Mass at St. Paul Outside the Walls Basilica

### Oct 03 Thurs – Vatican / Diaconate Ordination

This morning you will be transferred to St. Peter's Basilica to

attend mass at the "Altar of the Chair", celebrating the Diaconate Ordination. Following Mass, you will attend the reception at the North American College on the Janiculum Hill. Depending on when the reception ends, you may visit the ancient Colosseum, view the Roman Forum and Mamertine Prison, where Paul was imprisoned, and see the Trevi Fountain before heading back to your hotel for dinner and overnight. **Mass at St. Peter's Basilica**

### Oct 04 Fri – Assisi

Morning departure to Assisi where you will visit St. Francis Basilica for Mass and a visit to the Chapel of St. Catherine. Tour of Assisi to include St. Francis Chapel, the Rose Garden, St. Francis Cave, and the chapel of his death. See the Tomb of St. Francis, then visit St. Claire's Church where her body lies intact and where the famous St. Damiano Crucifix, which spoke to St. Francis, is located. Dinner and overnight in Rome. **Mass at St. Francis of Assisi Basilica**

### Oct 05 Sat – Rome / Frankfurt / Houston

Morning transfer to the airport for your flight to Frankfurt, connecting with Lufthansa flight back to Houston.
