Seminary Pilgrimage Fund

All Knights and Dames who have made a pilgrimage to the Holy Land come away with a heightened understanding of the plight of the Christians living there, in addition to experiencing what many Biblical theologians call the Fifth Gospel. The Southwestern Lieutenancy sponsors pilgrimages for seminarians while in their last year of seminary, just prior to their ordination. Although some funds are available from the Lieutenancy, they are insufficient to allow all seminarians to make a pilgrimage. To specifically allow seminarians from the Diocese of Fort Worth to have this opportunity, we have recently set up a special fund at the Advancement Foundation of the Diocese of Fort Worth - a Seminarian Pilgrimage Fund. This fund is intended to give our FW seminarians an opportunity to experience the Gospel in the Holy Land, as well as see firsthand the situation of the Holy Land Christians, by making a pilgrimage prior to their ordination. Donations can be made to the Advancement Foundation by specifying that the donation goes to the Seminarian Pilgrimage Fund. Special thanks to Dame Renee Underwood for setting this up with the Advancement Foundation.
